

YOUR STEP-BY-STEP DESIGN GUIDE

Step ① What size do I need?

Assess the size of the items you need to store. Consider additional uses you may have for your Duratuf Kiwi Garden Shed, such as a workshop, cook house, changing room, playhouse etc. Select a size that fits and works best for you.

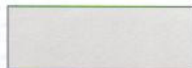
Step ② What finish do I want?

Zinc/Aluminium – throughout.

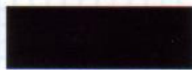
Option B:



Titania walls with your choice of the following colours for roof, door and trim.



Permanent Green



Ironsand



Scoria



Karakas



Grey Friars

Special colours

If you would like your shed to be in one colour all over, or in a colour not featured here, Duratuf Kiwi Garden Sheds can be customised to meet most requirements. Have your shed so it blends with your surroundings. Discuss your colour preferences with your retailer. *Surcharge applies.*

Step ③ Do I want to change where the door goes?

If preferred, single doors can be repositioned to the gable end as pictured. This is ideal for tight spaces or for the storage of long objects, such as kayaks, mobility scooters etc. For other relocation options, speak to your retailer. *Surcharge applies.*



Step ④ Do I need extra daylight or ventilation?

Clear roof panels

Duratuf Clear Roof Panels can provide UV free natural daylight into any of the Duratuf shed range, ideal for a workshop situation. Choose from either single or double clear panels - one side or both sides of the central ridge beam on gable roofs.

Please note that clear panels condensate more than steel.



Windows

Available in four blade louvre or fixed pane, the window opening is pre-cut at the time of manufacture in the position of your choice. The kit includes, frame, glass, window, extra studs, nog, and hardware. Please note that windows cannot be positioned behind the door in open position.
